Description

Participants in this two-day course will receive instruction in developing and implementing an AHERA level management plan for asbestos in buildings.

Learning Objectives

1. List the AHERA requirements for inspection reports and management plans.
2. Write, prepare and format survey data for use in hazard assessment.
3. Identify the necessary records from the inspection report to include in the management plan.
4. Describe the differences between physical assessment and hazard assessment.
5. List various approaches to hazard assessment.
6. Apply the decision tree approach to hazard assessment.
7. Define the seven hazard ranking classifications described by AHERA and classify ACBM accordingly.
8. Identify the liabilities incurred by a Management Planner and apply measures to reduce this liability.
9. List the five main AHERA response actions.
10. Describe the purpose of an Operations and Maintenance program and recognize the elements of an O&M program.
11. Develop and apply an Operations & Maintenance plan.
12. Identify the various regulations which may have an effect on management planners.
13. Name and describe any applicable state or local asbestos regulations concerning management planners.
14. Identify which documents and records need to be retained and list the benefits of complete documentation.
15. Identify the components of a complete management plan.
16. List the factors involved in estimating the costs for implementing an asbestos control program.
