



**Asbestos Inspector/Management Planner Refresher**  
**AS205**

**Description**

This eight (8) hour refresher course consists of a four hour refresher for the inspector course and a four hour refresher for the management planner course. This course will provide the most current information on regulations and safety practices as well as state-of-the-art procedures. Federal regulations require that all AHERA certified asbestos professionals complete approved annual refresher courses in order to maintain their certification. A written examination is given to participants who have current certification.

**Prerequisites**

Students must have completed an EPA-approved Inspector and/or Management Planner course or refresher within the last two years.
