Description

This course will teach you advanced e-commerce techniques and introduce new sales strategies for your existing WooCommerce website. Once you have the basic knowledge of WooCommerce, this class will take the next steps to add additional functionality to your store and provide a better understanding of the WooCommerce system.

Prerequisites

Website in a Weeknight (or equivalent experience with basic Wordpress)

Learning Objectives

1. Identify the location of and modify WooCommerce pages: archive, single product, cart & account pages.
2. Add conditional free shipping & local pickup options to your store.
3. Implement product grouping for maximum product exposure.
4. Add digital downloads as a product in your store.
5. Build an advanced sidebar with categories, cart & search.
6. Add coupons to your store
7. Add site-wide store notices.
