Learning Objectives

1. Practice basic basic infection control procedures.
2. Observe, report, and document client status and care/services rendered.
3. Identify and provide for developmental needs of clients according to the plan of care.
4. Discuss the role of the Home Health Care Aide in providing verbal reminders to clients to medications at appropriate times.
5. Explain safety procedures to follow when providing household services.
6. Consider client rights when providing care.
7. Demonstrate patient care skills in a lab setting.
8. Practice communication skills for both clients and other healthcare workers.
9. Perform vital signs.
10. Discuss basic elements of body functioning and changes in body function that must be reported to the aide's supervisor.
11. Recognize an emergency and necessary emergency procedures.
12. Demonstrate safe transfer techniques and ambulation.
13. Discuss and demonstrate normal range of motion and positioning.
14. Identify principles of adequate nutrition and fluid intake.
