Learning Objectives

1. Identify and determine appropriate responses that define the scope of practice of a LTC Aide
2. Provide safe, efficient care for residents promoting comfort, healing, and recovery while recognizing the normal changes related to aging
3. Identify and anticipate risk factors for the resident and LTC Aide as well as demonstrate infection control measures
4. Perform correct body mechanics when transferring, transporting, and ambulating clients/residents
5. Assist residents with daily grooming and hygiene needs
6. Assist residents with urinary and bowel elimination and report observations to other members of the healthcare team
7. Assist residents with proper nutrition and fluid in order to promote health
8. Assist other members of the healthcare team with patient assessment by measuring and recording vital signs, intake and output, and height and weight
9. Demonstrate an understanding of confusion and dementia and the effects they have on a person's ability to think
10. Identify emergency situations and respond within the scope of the nursing assistant
11. Approach the dying person with compassion and respect
