**Description**

This class provides the MAT with the required 8 hours of annual continuing education in infection control.

**Learning Objectives**

1. Distinguish among types of microbes that can cause an infection
2. Name the links in the "chain of infection"
3. List common ways that microbes can spread infection.
4. Guidelines for preventing infection through good personal hygiene.
5. State special precautions relating to blood spills/body fluids
