**MAT Update - (OLT) Control Infection**

**Description**

This course is an instructor lead online learning program. It provides the required 8 hours of continuing education for the Medication Administration Technician. There is no lab required. All curriculum will be provided online.

**Prerequisites**

Must be a non-expired Medication Administration Technician. An email address and internet access is required for enrollment in this course. Students will have four weeks to complete this online course.

**Learning Objectives**

1. Distinguish among types of microbes that can cause an infection.
2. Name the links in the "chain of infection."
3. List common ways that microbes can spread infection.
4. Select from a list guidelines for preventing infection through good personal hygiene.
5. Select from a list guidelines for preventing infection through good housekeeping.
6. State special precautions relating to blood spills/body fluids.
