Description

In April 2018, the Oklahoma County Assessor's office launched a new property transaction search engine and mobile app that are unlike any other in the state of Oklahoma and perhaps in the country. Some of the concerns the training will address will be: How would you like to find all the one-story homes sold or with ownership transferred in Oklahoma County in 2018? How about searching for vacant or improved land transactions by city or unincorporated areas of the country? How about finding all the sales or transfers of property involving car washes, apartments, storage facilities, two-story homes or split levels?

Learning Objectives

- Students will identify where to find the database on the Oklahoma County Assessor website from a desktop computer
- Students will recognize which mobile app to use for searching Oklahoma County Assessor records available in the Apple and Google stores
- Students will discuss search techniques to find specific property specifications in the Oklahoma County area
