



**Siding Installation for Construction**

**Description**

This is a job pathway course. Under the tutelage of industry experts using manufacturers' manuals and materials, students will learn installation and repair of siding. This class will concentrate on vinyl siding. Class will include industry standards for installation and repairs. Students will be introduced to concepts regarding owning your own company. This class will incorporate hands on learning at actual job sites under a mentor and job foreman, preparing students for entry jobs into the siding industry. Students will have the opportunity to apply for jobs after successfully completing the class, and must be able to pass a drug screen. Students may opt to test for VSI (Vinyl Siding Institute) certification. Certification is at the expense and option of the student and is not part of the tuition or required for class completion.

Students will:

1. Demonstrate basic construction skills, such as measuring, cutting, use of hand tools
2. List hazards of siding installation and safety measures required
3. Describe Customer Service issues and possible resolutions
4. Identify problems/issues, given installation and repair scenarios
5. Demonstrate installation skills at a job site.
