**Description**

Teaching with the GoPro Camera will give instructors 2 possible scenarios for using it in the classroom. The GoPro can be secured on a table or tripod and will video a demonstration that can be used for future reference or used online. Additionally the GoPro can be synced with an iPad or PC to project close detailed demonstration on a large screen for student viewing.

**Learning Objectives**

1. Discuss why to use a GoPro camera in the classroom.
2. Demonstrate using the GoPro for recording and saving the video to use at a later time.
3. Create a demonstration using the GoPro camera to project close work onto a screen using a PC, iPad or iPhone.
